2012 BOBCAT'S & ANGLER'S CHOICE BASS TRAIL TOURNAMENT RULES

1- Membership – Each Angler entering the Trail is required to pay a \$25.00 membership fee. Anyone under the age of 15 will not be charged a membership fee.

2- Teams consist of two (2) anglers. Single anglers will be allowed to enter Qualifier events, but also must fish Classic as single angler. Each angler must possess a valid fishing license. Each angler must abide by state and federal fishing regulations.

3- SUBS- A sub fee of \$15.00 is due when a sub is used during any Qualifier event. A team may use a sub at any two Qualifiers. A team may not consist of a partner from another team who has previously entered an event in the same year with another partner.

4- Classic Qualifications – A team must enter 4 Qualifiers to be eligible to enter the Classic and Anglers Choice BIG BASS of YEAR. A Classic team must consist of the 2 original partners or a team may split and fish the Classic as two singles. No subs are allowed at the Classic.

5- Points – 5 show-up points will be awarded at each Qualifier. First place 100 points. Second place 99 points, etc. The last Qualifier for the year will be a double point event. The Trail point winner will receive free entry fees for 2013.

6- Start Time – The majority of the Trail events will begin at safe light and end at 3:00pm unless weather is a factor. Please be on time for Blast Off.

7- Limits – All Trail events have a 5 bass limit, 14 inches. A 4 ounce penalty will be deducted for each dead fish weighed. The 4 ounce penalty will not be deducted from teams Big Fish but will be deducted from the team's total weight. A team bringing more than 5 fish to the scales will result in loss of teams Biggest Fish.

8- Blast Off Positions – Blast off positions is determined by order of payment.

9- Cull Rule – Cull when 5 fish limit is reached.

10- Ties – In the event of a tie. Ties will be broken by the amount of points gathered by the team throughout the year. Big Fish will be used to break tie at first event.

11- Late Penalty – 1 pound per minute will be deducted from a team's total weight for each minute the team is late. 15 minutes past the designated weigh-in time will result in disqualification.

12 - Polygraph – Winners and participants are subject to a polygraph exam at any Trail event. Any angler who has failed a polygraph exam in the past will not be allowed to enter a Trail event. Refusal to take a polygraph for ANY reason will result in disqualification.

13- Alcohol, Illegal Drugs – No Alcohol or Illegal Drugs during tournament hours.

14- Cell Phones - may be used during tournament hours ONLY for family or Emergency calls. No cell phone discussions pertaining to fishing during tournament hours.

15- Entry Fees – Pre-paid fees are refundable if conflicts arise causing a team to miss (Director of Bass Trail must be notified before start of tournament).

16- Both Life Jacket and Kill Switch must be in use when big motor is in operation. Failure to comply will result in disqualification. Life Jacket must be Coast Guard approved.

17- A team member can exit the boat in case of the call of nature, emergency, or paying for gas. A team member cannot exit the boat in order to advance the boat into a fishing area.

18- Protests- All protests should be made to the Bass Trail director. All Bass Trail director's decisions are final.

19- All anglers are responsible for parking fees at ramps.

20- Insurance – All boat operators must have documented proof of a minimum of \$100,000 per occurrence boating liability insurance covering the boat being used. Proof of insurance must be with the boat being used and must cover the competitors using that boat. Random checks may be conducted at registration and/or tournament weigh-in and any competitor not in compliance may be disqualified.
